Metal spikes are not allowed at Park Ridge Country Club.

Registration on Tournament Day:

Upon arriving at Park Ridge Country Club, we ask that you please register in the Pro Shop. You will receive a tournament credential that will entitle you to a complimentary continental breakfast, fruit and drink on the course, and a BBQ lunch in our dining room. We are encouraging contestants to stay until the tournament is completed and enjoy the festivities.

Locker Room:

You will have full use of our locker room.

Please note that when inside our clubhouse, a face-covering mask is required.

Tee-Off times:

Tee times will begin at 8:00 a.m. with 10-minute intervals. Contestants will be paired in threesomes. **Check the Park Ridge Country Club Website for pairings [Go to: www.parkridgecc.org. From**

the top menu select “Champion of Champions” then “2020 Event”]. *Tee times will be posted no later than Sunday October 4. Tee times may change slightly through Wednesday, October 7. If the change affects you, we will contact you by phone or email. Please note that if you arrive late for the assigned tee time, the penalty is disqualification.*

Each threesome will have a Park Ridge Country Club host/hostess. They will have immediate access to tournament officials.

Practice Rounds:

A complimentary practice round (caddie or golf cart at the contestant’s expense) may be played through October 7, subject to certain restrictions.
